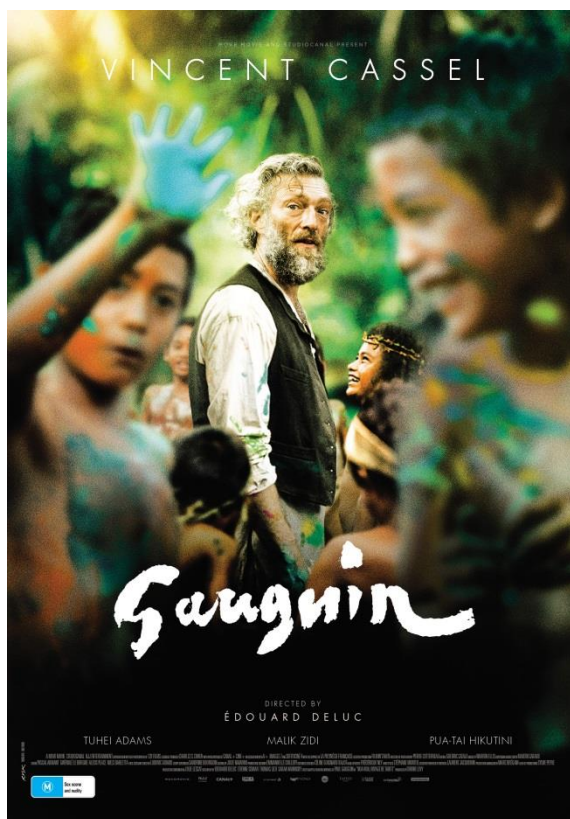


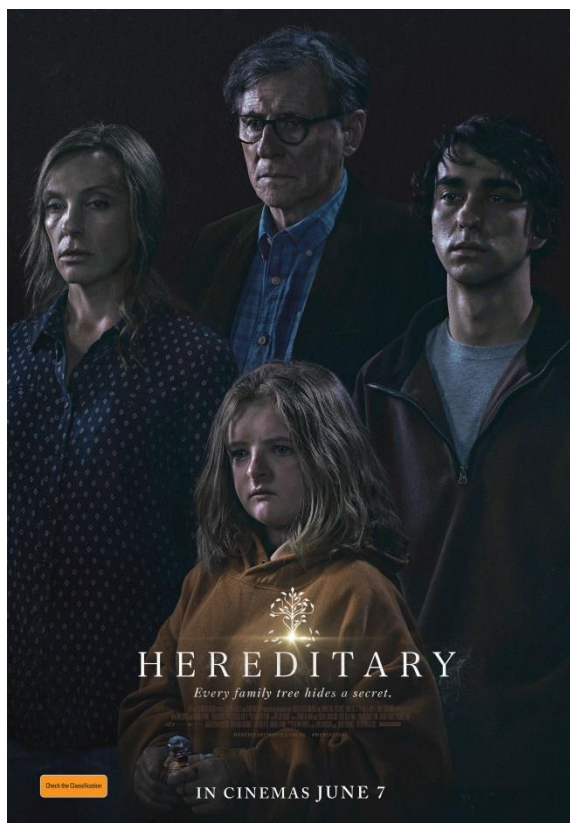

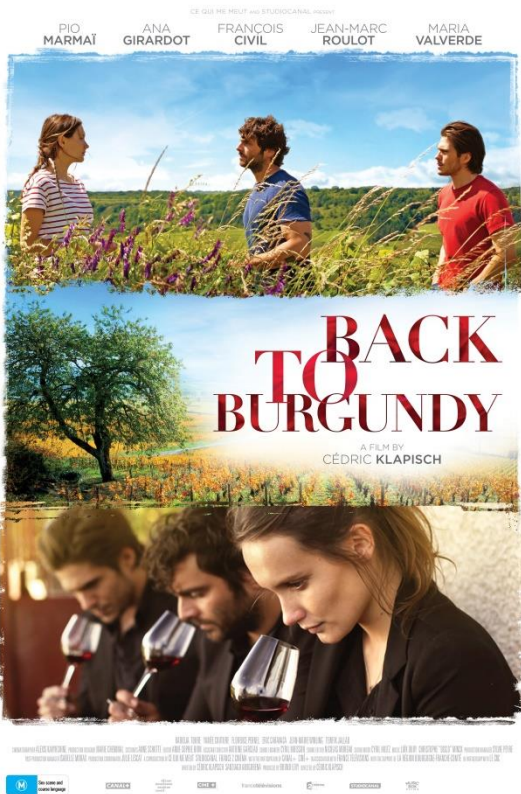


HEREDITARY

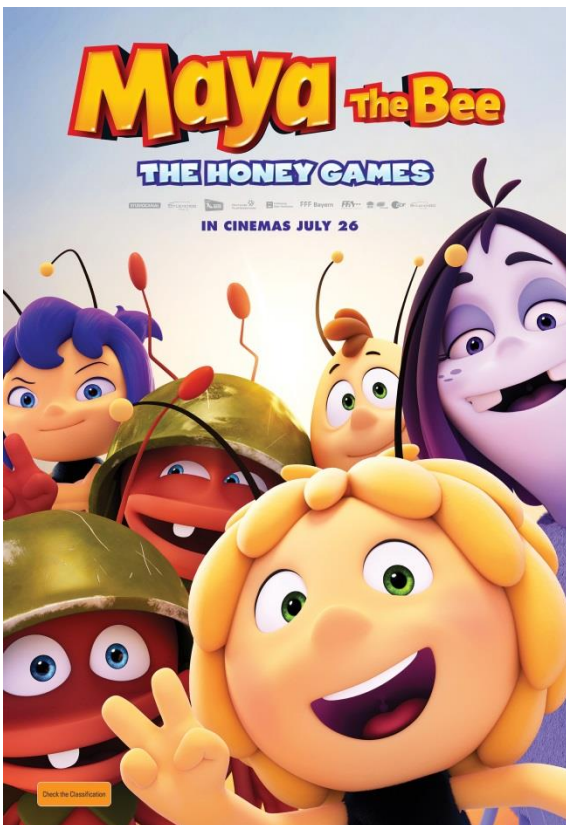


BACK TO BURGUNDY
